
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
NO. 2000-41

The Superior Court has been asked to provide assistance to the Kingman Municipal Court in the supervision of adult persons placed on probation. The Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Mohave County has administrative authority over the probation department and the probation department has the expertise to provide such assistance. Further A.R.S. § 12-251 provides the enabling authority for the probation department to provide probation services to municipal courts.

THE COURT, BELIEVING THAT IT IS IN THE INTERESTS OF JUSTICE,
THEREFORE ORDERS THAT:

1. The Kingman Municipal Court may request assignment of probation officers to supervise adult offenders.
2. When Kingman Municipal Court orders supervised probation, the court shall forward a copy of the order to the probation department to open a supervision case in the manner agreed to between the court and the probation department.
3. Municipal Court offenders who are placed on supervised probation shall be required to pay a \$40.00 per month supervision fee pursuant to A.R.S. 13-901(A). Said funds are to be paid to Kingman Municipal Court and ultimately transmitted to the County Treasurer for deposit in the probation services fund established by A.R.S. § 12-267.
4. Offenders placed on supervised probation by the Kingman Municipal Court may be arrested by the supervising probation officer without a warrant for violations of the terms of the probation.
5. In the event that the probation department is unable to provide supervision the department shall immediately notify the Kingman Municipal Court.
6. This order is in effect until an intergovernmental agreement is established between the municipality and county or rescinded by this court.
